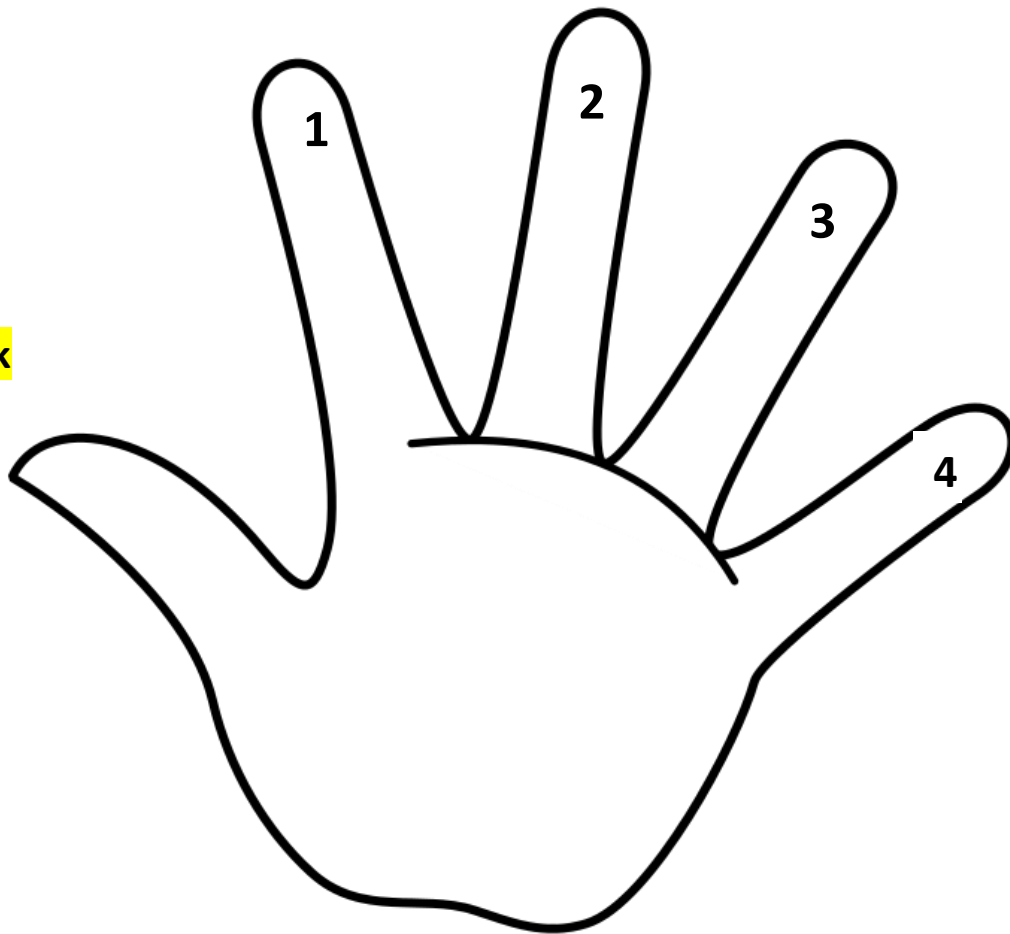


What Finger Do I Use Where???

When we play the ukulele, we use our LEFT hand to change note and chords on the neck of the instrument. We use only our index (1), middle (2), ring (3) and pinky (4) fingers. This is because our left thumb is already busy holding the instrument in the back.

The THUMB
rests in the
middle of the
BACK of the
fretboard/neck



How Do I Hold This Thing Anyway???

You hold ukulele across your body, against your chest/stomach area.

The fretboard (or neck) of the ukulele should point towards the LEFT and be held in the LEFT hand.

Your RIGHT hand should be positioned just over the tone hole, ready to strum the strings.



(I rotated the picture so you could mirror his holding position.)
